

Dear parent/guardian:

As you are aware, driving and parking on campus is a privilege that is available to seniors. Since our concern is to provide a safe and orderly high school environment, it is important that we all work together to ensure that driving on campus is done in a responsible manner.

Please be reminded that no student will be allowed to park on campus without having **attended the Choices & Consequences driving meeting** with a parent/guardian. Also, a **driving tag will only be issued upon receipt of a D license and a signed contract.** Please refer to the following link:

Due to a limited number of parking spots available to seniors who wish to drive, a parking plan has been created, approved, and voted upon by the Senior Class. **Students will be limited to certain days on which they may drive.** The breakdown is as follows:

Pink Group - Birthdates June 1, 1991 through February 29, 1992

Green Group - Birthdates from March 1, 1992 through June 30, 1992

Yellow Group - Birthdates July 1, 1992 or later

Members of the Pink Group will be allowed to drive on Tuesday only throughout the year. However, during the months of September, December, and March they may also drive on Monday and Friday.

Members of the Green Group will be allowed to drive on Wednesday only throughout the year. However, during the months of October, January, and April they may also drive on Monday and Friday.

Members of the Yellow Group will be allowed to drive on Thursday only throughout the year. However, during the months of November, February, and May they may also drive on Monday and Friday.

A change can only be made if there is another student with whom your child may switch, and the rationale for such a switch is deemed valid. All requests **must** be approved by Ms. Appiarus. Request forms are in the office and will be honored provided there is a vacancy. The switch will be on a first come first serve basis and all changes are **FINAL**.

Only students with a D license may obtain a driving tag. They may pick up their driving tag from the office beginning Tuesday, July 7, 2009. Please bring the original D license, the registration of the car(s) student will be driving to school, and the signed Senior Driving Guideline and Contract.

Thank you for your cooperation. I realize that this is a very important part of the senior experience and look forward to a happy and safe school year.
